

Care projects projects provide sustainable educational support and individualised attention to children with the aim of enhancing their physical, social, emotional, and cognitive development. As a volunteer, you will assist staff members by helping at meal times, creating educational resources, and playing with the children. The Care & Community projects involve practical renovation projects, often in schools or community centres. You will get involved with refurbishing buildings, painting murals, and planting gardens. Each year we pick different placements depending on the needs of the community and size of the group. You will work at either a day care centre, community centres, kindergarten, or local school. Volunteers will live with local host families or in shared apartments, a guesthouse or a hotel.



#### **Care & Community in Ethiopia**

**WHERE:** Addis Ababa

#### Safe Accommodation

After their busy day is completed, volunteers return home to their host family in groups of two or more per family. In a few cases, volunteers stay together as a group in a hotel or dorm-style building that we manage, with their supervisors on-site. In most cases, volunteers have at least one roommate of the same sex and approximate age.

# Programme Fee What's included



#### **Accommodation**

Volunteers usually stay with host families who are carefully selected by our staff. Living in the local community is truly the best way to achieve a meaningful cultural exchange. When, due to logistical or geographical reasons, it is not possible to place volunteers with host families, they will live in shared accommodation as a group with a staff member.



#### Meals

You will receive 3 meals every day, usually breakfast and dinner with your host family and lunch at your placement. Where volunteers live in shared accommodation we provide a local cook or stipend.



#### **Ground Transportation**

Our local staff will greet every volunteer once they arrive at the airport. We also provide transportation back to the airport for their departure.

During the project, we provide transportation to and from the work placements, as well as evening and weekend activities.



#### **Weekend Activities & Cultural Events**

Each programme includes planned weekend activities and cultural events organised and supervised by our local staff. These activities allow volunteers to relax and explore beautiful tourist attractions, historical sites or natural reserves.



#### Insurance

You will receive insurance cover for medical and emergency travel expenses, luggage and personal effects, money, cancellation and curtailment, rescue and assistance, legal expenses and travel delay. Cover becomes effective once full payment has been received.



### 24 hour support from our staff

Every country has at least one Projects Abroad Office, with a Country Director and full-time staff. They are trained to follow best practices, including monitoring, security, and emergency procedures. They assist with any concerns, problems, advice, and general administration that may arise during your time abroad. They also maintain in close contact with the UK Office. Staff are available during the day at the office and directly contactable 24 hours a day by phone.







# **Getting There and Back**



Although flights are not included in the programme fee, there are several ways we can help you get to and from the project safely and stress-free.

#### **Travel Team**

Our experienced Travel Team offers a personalised booking service, drawing on decades of arranging flights for thousands of volunteers to countries around the world. With Projects Abroad planning your flights and keeping an eye on all the details, you have more time to focus on other preparations for your trip. This is an optional service and you are welcome to arrange your own flights.

No matter who books the flights, every volunteer is met at their destination airport by our in-country staff.



Although not always possible, many volunteers travel to their destination with another volunteer. Our staff can help you find another volunteer who will be travelling on some (or all) of your route, so you can fly together. We can also help you share contact information beforehand, and coordinate the purchase of your flights. Please contact us a few months before the project begins to make these arrangements.











# Speak to Projects Abroad Alumni There's an easy way to see if the Projects Abroad experience is right for you;

ask the people who've already been on one of our programmes! Call us for the names and contact information of volunteers who have worked in the places that interest you.

#### Visas, Insurance, and Vaccinations

If a visa is required for your destination, we will give you the relevant documents and advice. Prices for visas vary from £20 to £300 according to

Projects Abroad prices include insurance coverage for your outward and return journeys (except for overnight stays in your home country) and throughout your placement.

Coverage becomes effective once full payment has been received. Extra leisure travel insurance can also be arranged for an additional premium.

We advise you to consult your doctor or health centre for up-to-date information about vaccinations. Since we are not medical experts, our advice on vaccinations and other medical matters can only be informal.

#### Amendments and Cancellations

Amendments or cancellations may be notified to the UK office by telephone but they must be confirmed in writing. Our charge for an amendment is normally between £35 and £150. Cancellation and curtailment charges depend on how far in advance of your stated departure date we have been informed in writing.

- Notice of 3 months or more: £65
- Notice of 2 to 3 months: one third of total programme fee
- Notice of 1 to 2 months: two thirds of total programme fee
- Notice of less than one month: no refund

Deposits paid less than three months before the originally stated departure date are non-refundable. Exceptions are entirely at the discretion of Projects Abroad and must be agreed in writing at the time when any postponement or cancellation is made.
